JOB SUMMARY:

The Facilities/Food Pantry Assistant supports daily operations of the campus facilities and food pantry by maintaining a clean, safe, and functional environment for staff, children, youth and church attenders. This role reports directly to the Campus Director and requires a dependable, adaptable individual with strong communication skills, attention to detail, and the ability to adjust quickly to changing needs. The ideal candidate is hands-on, safety-conscious, and comfortable performing physical tasks.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist with weekly operations of the food pantry, including receiving, organizing, stocking, and distributing food and supplies
- Move and transport items weighing up to 20-30 pounds using pallet movers or carts
- Support basic building maintenance tasks including
 - o minor repairs such as paint touch up/patch small holes/dings caused by kids toys
 - o spot clean auditorium carpet
 - Emergency clean up of food/drink spill, etc.
- Event setup and teardown including: tables, banner stands, chairs, and trash cans, etc.
- Open and close the building as scheduled, ensuring security procedures are followed
- Seasonally manage ice melt. Lift 50 pound ice melt bags from pallet to a cart and transport (roll/push) to storage area
- Assist with snow removal and ice management during winter months
- Monitor facility conditions and report maintenance or safety concerns promptly
- Maintain organized storage areas and ensure proper inventory of paper products
- Communicate effectively with staff, volunteers, and visitors
- Adapt to changing priorities and respond to needs as they arise
- Follow all safety, health, and organizational policies and procedures
